Illness Policy

Do not bring your child to school if he/she has a fever or has had a fever, vomiting, diarrhea in the last 24 hours, or if they have had any signs of an illness or communicable disease. If your child becomes ill during the day, you will be called to come and pick him/her up. Reminder: please keep your cell phone with you and turned on while your child is in school. It is very important that we are able to reach you when needed. Please do not bring your child to school if they did not get enough rest the night before. They are not able to function without ample sleep.



REMINDERS:

It is very important that you label your child's belongings, lunch boxes, drink bottles, snack bags, jackets, gloves, etc. Please label the lunch boxes on the outside of the lunch box. If these items are not labeled they will be labeled with a permanent marker here at school.
