### An FYI

Most of the preschool staff live in Rio Rancho. If Rio Rancho receives snow and the roads are bad, the preschool will be closed. You will be contacted via text and teachers will send a bloomz message as well to keep you informed.

### Reminders

With cold weather upon us children are more prone to illness. If your child has any of the following symptoms now or in the past 24 hours, we ask that you keep him/her at home: a fever, rash, diarrhea, vomiting, pink eye, sore throat, discolored nasal discharge, constant cough, or any symptoms of a contagious illness or Covid. A good rule to follow when determining whether or not to send your child is, "when in doubt, don't."

We go outside everyday unless it's raining or snowing. Make sure that your child's belongings are clearly marked to avoid any confusion. Finally please make sure that your child has a good breakfast and has gone to the bathroom before coming to school, this helps him/her have a great start to their school day.
